 - Gjorgjevski: believes there is a difference between the City's 2% contribution and 3% increase in the HRAs
 - Reviewed side letter

 - Allen: difficulty would be changes in the payments and services provided; we need to make sure that we are comfortable with how to address those changes
 - McNeil: agrees with Allen's concerns; how do we know if payments change
 - Gjorgjevski: does it with other plans; usually for Medicare premium, which doesn't change; form is filled out by participant dealing with reoccurring payments; may lead to more fees from Fifth Third
 - BeneSys will provide the form, the pricing, and the process for the Board's approval
- Communication with Yvonne re whether members are vested and whether the pension is reduced or unreduced
 - Confusion with the documentation that is being submitted from the City

FIFTH THIRD—Michael Pavlick and Allan Kort

- Yield curve steepening
- Unemployment little over 4%
- Tariff distress did lead to lower job growth
- Floyd Allen: how will Iran War impact financial picture?
 - Iran is roughly 4% of oil production; doesn't impact global radar
 - Strait of Hormuz: over a third of oil transported thru the Strait
 - If conflict is protracted, the Strait becomes an issue and prices may rise
 - May lead to increase in interest rates and less likely to transact business
 - Portfolio is well diversified with fixed income to minimize risk
 - Short-term performance may be hit, but long-term may improve
- Investment review—allocations are at their policy level
 - Not overreaching in the risk space
 - Performance: Ahead on 1 Yr and 5 Yr and equity up
 - 9.6% return (earnings of over \$5million)
- Floyd Allen: would like another review from Fifth Third in May
